

School-level Contextual Factors in Relation to Severe Early Childhood Caries among Preschool Children: A Multilevel Analysis



Background

Dental caries is the severe oral health issue among preschool children in Taiwan. According to the dental caries prevalence of 5 years old Taiwanese children, it was showed that the oral health condition of preschool children remains below the standards set by the World Health Organization since preschool children spend much time in school. Therefore, contextual factors play an important role in school environment focused on broad social environment.

Objectives

This study aims to explore contextual factors associated with severe early childhood caries (SECC) among preschool children aged 3-5 years.

Methods

Preschool children aged 3-5 years were recruited in 2014 in Taipei city. Data collection was conducted by examination by dentists, and a self-administered questionnaire. SECC was defined as having ≥4 teeth with carious lesions (filled tooth) ≥4 mm in diameter.

The prevalence of SECC was 10.2% among children with SECC. The correlation coefficient between SECC and ECC among preschool children was $R = 0.83$, $95\% \text{ CI} = 0.75$, $95\% \text{ CI} = 0.95$. Adjusting for age, gender, and other variables, the adjusted $R = 0.75$, $95\% \text{ CI} = 0.68$, $95\% \text{ CI} = 0.82$.

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Conclusion

The specific school attended has a positive significant effect on the lower risk of having SECC. The findings suggest that effective strategies should be focused on health promoting environments in order to reduce caries development.



